The Southwest London Academic Network is holding a range of lunchtime Roadshow events across Kingston, Royal Holloway and St George's in October. These events will give staff across the three sites an opportunity to hear more about the research and teaching opportunities within the three institutes – of Biomedical and Life Sciences, of Leadership and Management, and the Interprofessional Institute (Health and Social Care) - which form part of the tripartite alliance.

Cherie Woolmer, Strategic Partnership Project Manager, says: "We have spent the summer term finalising the detailed operating plan for the alliance over the next three years. The three institutes have identified a variety of new programmes and research opportunities that they will be wishing to promote to staff during the academic year. These include seed funding for research collaborations, joint PhD studentships, and new undergraduate and postgraduate programmes in a variety of subject areas. In addition to the planning process, we have begun detailed work on academic regulations and learning technologies to support students and staff who will be working across the three institutions."

The roadshows will give staff an opportunity to meet staff involved with the three institutes as well as senior colleagues. People from different disciplines may well find they have research and teaching interests that span the institutes and so will benefit from having the chance to explore ideas
