Stanford University's Memorial Church was one of the earliest and is still among the most prominent interdenominational churches in the West. Its construction was completed in 1903. CHOIR OF ROYAL HOLLOWAY

Described by The Times as "truly fabulous" and "breathtakingly expressive," the Choir of Royal Holloway is one of the finest mixed-voice collegiate choirs in the UK.

In recent years the Choir has undertaken over 25 tours, including across Europe and the east coast of the USA, where it has featured in music festivals and broadcast on local radio and television. Following the success of their CDs on the Naxos and Signum labels, the Choir now records exclusively for Hyperion Records.

Their latest release, Time is endless, features the music of the contemporary Lithuanian composer Vytautas Miškinis and has already received outstanding reviews from Gramophone, Classic Fm Magazine and the BBC.

The Choir regularly performs with the London Mozart Players (LMP) orchestra including the première of a new oratorio from American composer Carson Cooman in the Cadogan Hall in 2009. The Choir has also worked with the period instrument ensembles Florilegium, Devon Baroque and the RCM Baroque Orchestra.
