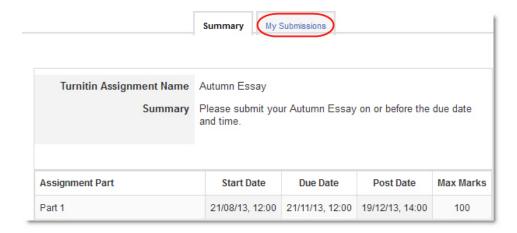
Submitting an assignment/essay to Turnitin (through Moodle) 2014

1. Logging in and accessing Turnitin

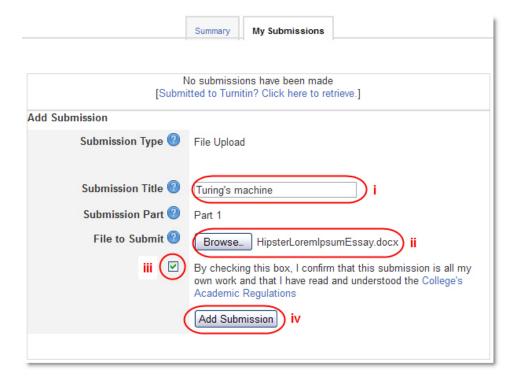
i. Log-on to Moodle, go to your course and click on the assignment.



- ii. The Assignment page will appear, showing the assignment instructions and the due date
- iii. Click on the My Submissions tab



2. Submitting an assignment or essay to Turnitin



- i. Enter a **Title** for your assignment do not enter your name as submissions are anonymous
- ii. Click **Browse** to find the file on your computer/network drive/USB stick ensuring it is **no larger than 20Mb**
- iii. Check the tick-box to confirm that you have read and understood the College's Academic Regulations
- iv. Click Add Submission to upload your work.

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3. Acknowledgment of a submission to Turnitin

Moodle will pass your submission to the Turnitin service. This process can take between 2 and 30 seconds, or longer at busy times during the academic year.



Once your submission is accepted, **you will receive a digital receipt by e-mail**. This is sent to your Royal Holloway account. Make sure you keep this, as you may need it as proof of submission

Once your submission is accepted, the following screen appears, and provides a record of your submission(s) for a given assignment, and allows you to download them if necessary:



Should you be required to submit further documents in support of your assignment then you will be reminded of this and should repeat **Step 2**.

4. Re-submitting an assignment or essay

Should you submit the wrong file, e.g., a draft or another essay, you can resubmit either from the acknowledgement screen above, or by repeating **Steps 1-2**.
