ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The below listed courses are open to all Study Abroad, International Exchange and Erasmus students, provided sufficient previous experience and knowledge as stated in the individual course prerequisites can be evidenced.

Level 1 courses: There are no formal pre-requisites for level 1 courses, however a good mathematical background is seen as very beneficial to students.

Level 2 courses: A solid foundation in micro and macroeconomics is required for Level 2 courses, as well as completion of a first year undergraduate mathematics/statistics course for economics.

Level 3 courses: Advanced knowledge and extensive experience in the subject area is *required* for level 3 courses; at least two years of Economics, Econometrics and maths for Economics knowledge is *expected* for 3rd year courses. Please note that these are advanced courses, typically equal to senior year/graduate level in the USA.
