**AGREED:** to remove the non-discrimination statement from the Principles of the Statutes on the grounds that this was enshrined in law and therefore did not need to be duplicated here. **14/04**

**AGREED:** to remove the current Statute 8 on collective responsibility from Statute to Council regulations. **14/05**

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| <b>NOTED:</b> that the Students' Union are currently revising their governance documents and are proposing to replace the current arrangements namely four sabbatical officers: President, Vice President Education and Welfare, Vice President Communication and Campaigns, and Vice President Student Activities. Noted that the students currently have two seats on Council: one the President ex officio, and one directly elected by the student body, a process managed by the Students' Union. Noted that the Council has expressed the wish to retain the President as an ex officio member. | <b>14/06</b> |
