Easter opening hours extended

The library will continue its term-time opening hours into the Easter Vacation. So, whether you need to write coursework, finish your dissertation or want to revise for the exams, the library's services and resources will be at your disposal just as they are during the spring term.

For the first time ever the libraries will be also open during the traditional College Easter closure dates, from the Wednesday before Easter until Easter Monday, to give you maximum access to library resources and study spaces. The libraries will also open their doors on the additional public holiday on 29 April 2011 and on the May Day holiday (2 May 2011).
