## Academic entry requirements

### Undergraduate

Higher Secondary Certificate in India will be considered with a minimum overall aggregate of at least 80% for most boards, or 75% for West Bengal Board and 85% for South India Board. A-Levels and the International Baccalaureate will also be considered.

### Postgraduate

Exact requirements will depend upon the programme you are planning to study at Royal Holloway and the university you have studied at, but departments will usually require a First Class degree, around 60% overall across all semesters.
