## ▶ Royal Holloway moves up in the Guardian University League Table 2022

For the second successive year, Royal Holloway, rose ten places in The Guardian's University League Table, placing it at number 22. Royal Holloway received an overall score of 82 out of 100 for overall student satisfaction with courses and 83 out of 100 satisfaction with teaching.



## ▶ Sound of an Egyptian mummy heard again for first time in 3,000 years

The sound of a mummified Egyptian priest was heard for the first time in 3,000 years, thanks to ingenious research by academics in the Department of Electronic Engineering at Royal Holloway, with the University of York and Leeds Museum and Galleries.

The sound of the 3,000 year old mummified Egyptian priest, Nesyamun, were accurately reproduced as a vowel-like sound based on measurements of the precise dimensions of his extant vocal tract following Computed Tomography (CT) scanning. This enabled the creation of a 3-D printed vocal tract, known as the Vocal Tract Organ.

## ▶ StoryTrails commissioned for UNBOXED: Creativity in the UK

In spring 2021, StoryFutures Academy, the National Centre for Immersive Storytelling, run by Royal Holloway and the National Film and Television School, was commissioned to work with partners to develop one of 10 projects for an UNBOXED: Creativity in the UK. This is a ground-breaking UK-wide celebration of creativity in 2022 that will bring people together in the UK's most ambitious showcase of creative collaboration.

The project, called StoryTrails, is a unique immersive storytelling experience where untold stories from the past are brought to life through the magic of the 3D internet using augmented and virtual reality to reanimate public spaces in towns and cities across the UK. Audiences will time-travel via the wonder of new technologies to experience untold local histories where they happened.

## ▶ Academics win prestigious award for Blood Bricks research

Professor Katherine Brickell and Dr Laurie Parsons from the Department of Geography, won a prestigious Times Higher (THE) Award for their 'Blood Bricks' research into modern slavery and climate change in Cambodia.

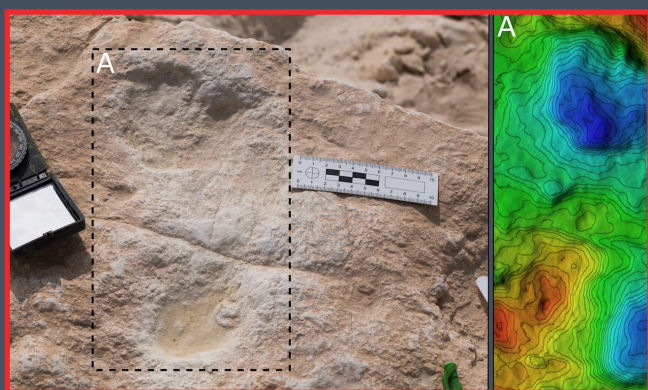
'Blood Bricks' was recognised in the Research Project of the Year for Arts, Humanities & Social Sciences category. The Blood Bricks project brought together a team of British and Cambodian researchers to explore, for the first time, the links between climate change and modern-day slavery in brick kilns in Cambodia.

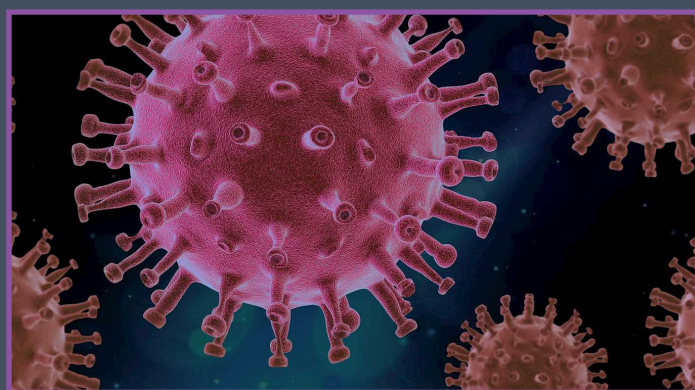
## ▶ Royal Holloway academic's Describing Diversity report influenced ITV's new audio-description policy

Broadcaster ITV credited research by Professor Hannah Thompson from the Department of Languages, Literatures and Cultures and VocalEyes, for directly influencing its new audio-description (AD) policy. ITV's policy sets out how the company will investigate and implement new guidance to govern how its AD service conveys race and other visible diversity cues to blind and visually impaired audiences.



## ▶ Ancient human footprints in Saudi Arabia provide earliest evidence of humans on the Arabian Peninsula

Archaeological research from the Department of Geography presented the oldest securely dated evidence for humans in Arabia. Discovered in the Nefud Desert in Saudi Arabia, along with human footprints, the researchers were able to identify footprints also belonging to elephants, horses and camels, which have been exposed following the erosion of overlying sediments.



## ▶ New nasal spray proven to kill 99.9% of the coronavirus that causes Covid-19 being trialled in the UK

Professor Pankaj Sharma from the Department of Biological Sciences played an instrumental part in the first UK clinical trials of a nasal spray proven to kill 99.9% of the coronavirus that causes Covid-19.

The SaNOTize Nitric Oxide Nasal Spray (NONS) is designed to kill the virus in the upper airways, preventing it from incubating and spreading to the lungs.

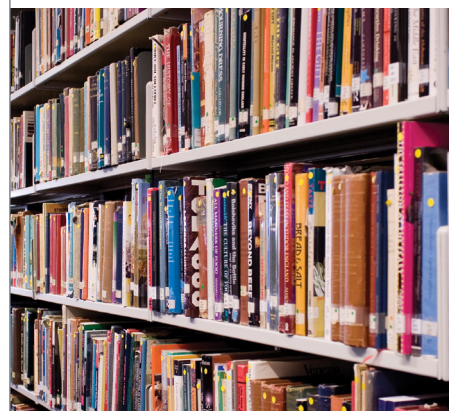

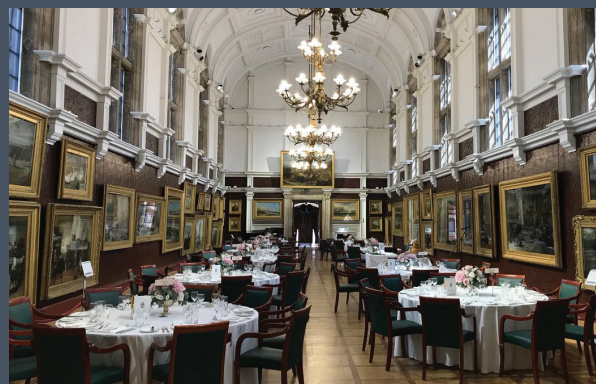

# History of the College

Royal Holloway College and Bedford College, each with long and distinguished histories, merged together through an Act of Parliament in 1985 to form the university we know today as Royal Holloway, University of London.

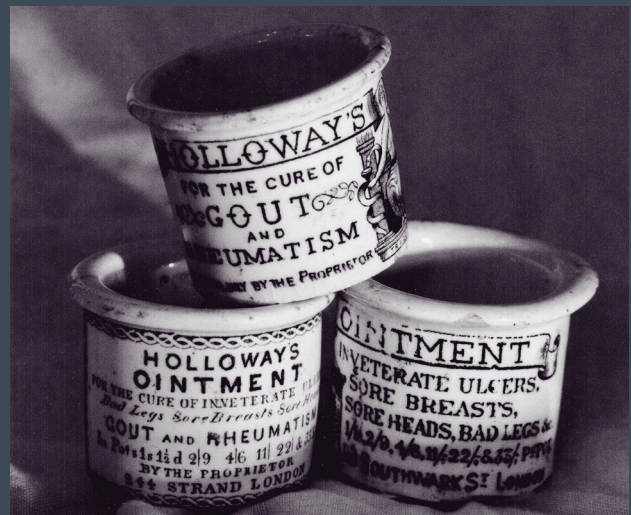
Bedford College was the inspiration of the pioneering social reformer Elizabeth Jesser Reid and was founded in 1849 as the first college for the higher education of women. It was sited at various locations in central London before finding a base in Regent's Park in 1913 where it remained until the time of the merger.

Royal Holloway College was opened by Queen Victoria in 1886, (pictured) who bestowed the title Royal. Its founder, Thomas Holloway, was a Victorian entrepreneur whose fortune was made in patent medicines, and the idea for a women's college came from his wife, Jane. Early in its history, the College was housed completely in the magnificent Founder's Building which also provided a home for the Royal Holloway Picture Collection, one of the world's most comprehensive private collections of Victorian art. Preserved in Founder's Picture Gallery, the Collection was the final touch to Holloway's generous endowment.

Both Colleges became part of the University of London in 1900 and both admitted male undergraduates for the first time in 1965. Then in the 1980s the two Colleges merged, building on the strengths of both to create a first class academic environment. The commitment to innovation and the egalitarian spirit which characterised the founders of both parent Colleges remains to this day.

The University of London was founded in 1836 to examine and grant degrees to the students of King's College and University College London. Up until then the only two English universities in existence were Oxford and Cambridge; both limited entrance to communicant members of the Church of England. Today the University of London is comprised of 17 independent institutions of varying size and is renowned for offering a world class education.

The tradition of Graduation Ceremonies within the University of London dates back to 1850 with the Royal Albert Hall being used as a venue for most of the last century. In 1992, the responsibility for organising the ceremonies was devolved to the Colleges so that ceremonies provided a more personal experience for our graduands and guests.



## Mace

The Ceremonial College Mace was created by Elizabeth Matthews, a local goldsmith. The design symbolises the Victorian heritage of both Royal Holloway and Bedford Colleges and also represents the College's present status as a multidisciplinary university institution committed to excellence in all its areas of activity. It is based on the Octagon of the Founder's Building. The head of the Mace, knobs and handholds are in gold-plated silver and the shaft is made of rosewood; this represents the contrast of the red brick, characteristic of the Founder's Building, with the Portland Stone of the Octagon. The College Coat of Arms has been embossed in enamel onto the floor of the replica of the Octagon.
