Which Game of Thrones leader
are you?



How Game of Thrones leaders can teach us a thing or two about management

What kind of manager would Jon Snow be in the office and how would having Daenerys Targaryen, Mother of Dragons, be as a leader for employees?

'Management Lessons from Game of Thrones' by Professor Fiona Moore from the School of Business and Management at Royal Holloway, demonstrates how the skills of the Game of Thrones characters could help those in real life, lead their teams to success. The book explores aspects of Westerosi society and politics whilst revealing how management theory influenced the world-building in the Game of Thrones franchise. It also outlines how students, academics and managers can draw on the series to further enhance their understanding of concepts in human resource management and organisation theory.



New Department of Health Studies opens

Our new Department of Health Studies offers a range of courses which aim to make a difference by connecting knowledge to global health-related challenges, promoting healthier populations and environments. The new department welcomed its first postgraduate students in September 2022 and builds on world-class research and interdisciplinary collaborations at Royal Holloway. Health Studies degrees will be taught by staff who are experts in their fields, drawing on their links with international research networks, and human and plan health collaborations across the world. These include the Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew and the Harvard-led Planetary Health Alliance.



Gold award for Cyber Security Excellence

Royal Holloway received a Gold award recognising excellence in cyber security education and good practice from the National Cyber Security Centre (NCSC). Already unique in being the only university in England to have full NCSC certification for all of its cyber security degree courses at both post and undergraduate level, the Academic Centre of Excellence in Cyber Security Education (ACE-CSE) Gold award builds on NCSC certification by offering universities a way to demonstrate their commitment to excellence in cyber security in the wider community. It involved a rigorous process in three key areas; building an influential and growing community of cyber security educators; shaping and supporting cyber security education; and engaging with industry, government, educators and students.

▶ StoryTrails completes its summer tour

StoryTrails, the UK's largest immersive storytelling project completed its summer tour of the UK, with thousands of people taking part across 15 towns and cities, which included a special residency at the British Film Institute (BFI) IMAX in London.

The StoryFutures Academy team trained and recruited 50 of the next generation of UK creative talent to help develop and deliver StoryTrails. These emerging creatives, a talented and dynamic cohort representative of the UK population, brought together diversity and innovation to chart a new course for the future of storytelling.

▶ Royal Holloway signs memorandum of understanding with Volodymyr Dahl East Ukrainian National University

In response to the war in Ukraine, Royal Holloway has signed a memorandum of understanding with Volodymyr Dahl East Ukrainian National University (VDEUNU), twinning the two institutions for the next five years.

The memorandum is part of the twinning partnerships initiative, Twin for Hope, by Cormack Consultancy Group together with Universities UK International (UUKi) to share resources, learning and ideas during the war against Ukraine. These long-term twinning partnerships will provide vital support in the short term, so Ukrainian students can continue their studies, and academics can carry on with their research. In the longer term, it means collaboration will help to rebuild campuses and play an important role in the rebuilding of Ukraine.

Presented at an awards ceremony in Central London in March 2022, the Global Women in Marketing Awards 2021 recognised the women making a difference and building back better in the marketing industries across the world.

Honorary Degree

The Rt Hon The Lord Hogan-Howe Kt QPM



The Rt Hon The Lord Hogan-Howe is a crossbench peer in the House of Lords.

Lord Hogan-Howe rose to the position of Commissioner for the Metropolitan Police Service, the most senior rank in the largest police force in the UK, between 2011–2017. During his time as Commissioner he established a ‘Total Policing’ strategy.

He started his career in policing with South Yorkshire Police, served as one of Her Majesty’s Inspectors of Constabulary 2009–2011 and was Chief Constable of Merseyside Police from 2005–2009.

In 2003 Lord Hogan-Howe was awarded the Queen’s Police Medal, he was knighted in 2013 for services to policing and was created a life peer in 2017. He is an advisor to a number of organisations and charities, and a Trustee of the Arise Foundation, a charity working to prevent slavery and human trafficking.

Lord Hogan-Howe will be awarded the degree of Doctor of Laws, *Honoris Causa*.

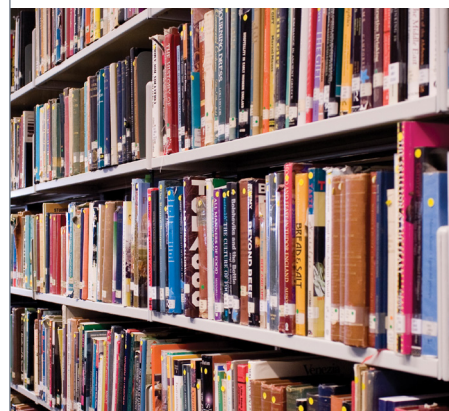

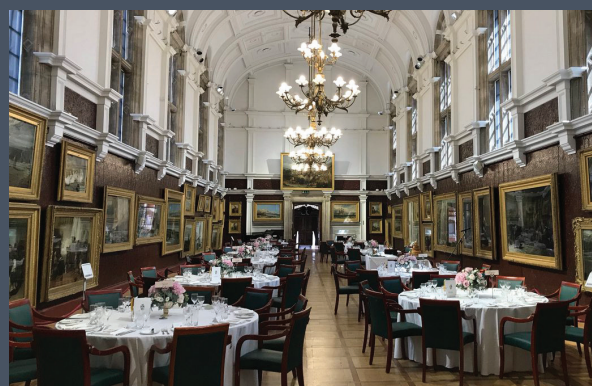

History of the university

Royal Holloway College and Bedford College, each with long and distinguished histories, merged together through an Act of Parliament in 1985 to form the university we know today as Royal Holloway, University of London.

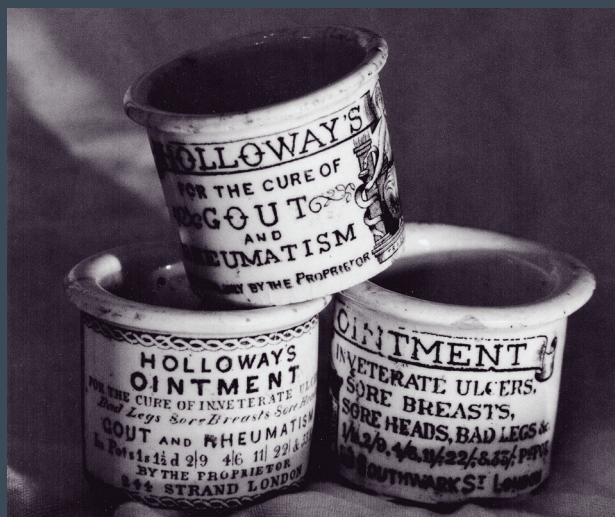
Bedford College was the inspiration of the pioneering social reformer Elizabeth Jesser Reid and was founded in 1849 as the first college for the higher education of women. It was sited at various locations in central London before finding a base in Regent's Park in 1913 where it remained until the time of the merger.

Royal Holloway College was opened by Queen Victoria in 1886, (pictured) who bestowed the title Royal. Its founder, Thomas Holloway, was a Victorian entrepreneur whose fortune was made in patent medicines, and the idea for a women's college came from his wife, Jane. Early in its history, the College was housed completely in the magnificent Founder's Building which also provided a home for the Royal Holloway Picture Collection, one of the world's most comprehensive private collections of Victorian art. Preserved in Founder's Picture Gallery, the Collection was the final touch to Holloway's generous endowment.

Both Colleges became part of the University of London in 1900 and both admitted male undergraduates for the first time in 1965. Then in the 1980s the two Colleges merged, building on the strengths of both to create a first class academic environment. The commitment to innovation and the egalitarian spirit which characterised the founders of both parent Colleges remains to this day.

The University of London was founded in 1836 to examine and grant degrees to the students of King's College and University College London. Up until then, the only two English universities in existence were Oxford and Cambridge; both limited entrance to communicant members of the Church of England. Today, the University of London is comprised of 17 independent institutions of varying size and is renowned for offering a world class education.

The tradition of Graduation Ceremonies within the University of London dates back to 1850 with the Royal Albert Hall being used as a venue for most of the last century. In 1992, the responsibility for organising the ceremonies was devolved to the Colleges so that ceremonies provided a more personal experience for our graduates and guests.



Mace

The Ceremonial College Mace was created by Elizabeth Matthews, a local goldsmith. The design symbolises the Victorian heritage of both Royal Holloway and Bedford Colleges and also represents the university's present status as a multidisciplinary university institution committed to excellence in all its areas of activity. It is based on the Octagon of the Founder's Building. The head of the Mace, knobs and handholds are in gold-plated silver and the shaft is made of rosewood; this represents the contrast of the red brick, characteristic of the Founder's Building, with the Portland Stone of the Octagon. The University Coat of Arms has been embossed in enamel onto the floor of the replica of the Octagon.
