### About the department

The Geography Department is one of the world's leading centres for geographical research and training. It has an outstanding reputation for offering a wide variety of exciting and accessible modules which may readily be combined with subjects from other disciplines. The range of modules on offer below reflects the breadth of the subject, from human geography to physical science. The Department offers particular specialism in the study of globalisation, development studies, environmental change, modern cities, consumerism, geopolitics and environmental management. ## **Entry requirements**
