

# Contemporary Britain Modules

## About the department

The Contemporary Britain modules are run by the Centre for the Development of Academic Skills (CeDAS). The topics studied will help students gain an understanding of culture and society in the UK during the post-war period - this can help to underpin their other studies at Royal Holloway which often refer to these important political and cultural events. The modules are also designed especially for students new to studying in the UK (both native speakers and non-native speakers of English). As part of this we offer students in-depth feedback on their writing, whether they are already proficient, or a bit uncertain in this regard. Overall the modules give opportunities to better understand how arts and humanities subjects are studied at undergraduate level in a British university. Although the modules are pitched at first year level, there are extended reading lists, meaning that more confident students can stretch themselves if they wish.

## Entry requirements

The modules listed below are open to all Study Abroad, International and Erasmus students, subject to any required previous knowledge or qualifications, as stated in the module outlines below.

Each module is 15 UK credits (½ unit) and starts in either the Autumn Term (September) or the Spring Term (January).
