About the conference

As a research student your task is to formulate fresh and exciting ideas, pushing the frontiers of your discipline in the search for knowledge. But as a researcher you are also required to share your research and think about its influence beyond the borders of your discipline, especially given the importance of research 'impact' to the [Research Excellence Framework](#).

Taking the form of a two-day conference, *Postgraduate Pioneers* will provide you with a forum in which to put this into practice, working with research students from other Faculties at Royal Holloway in order to showcase the research you are pursuing in your department.

Papers will be presented in a series of stimulating panels and you will also have the opportunity to run and attend student-led workshops. The conference will conclude with a plenary session in which panel chairs will lead an open discussion with all delegates on the subject of communicating research. The event will be followed by an evening reception with nibbles and wine; lunch will be provided on both days of the conference.
