

POSTGRADUATE VISITING STUDENTS 2011/12

There are three provisions for Postgraduate Visiting Students:

Study Abroad Masters Student: for PGT students only, student can stay for Term 1 only, or Terms 2 & 3 only, or the Full Year. The tuition fee for 2011/12 is £1,160 per month.

Accommodation is not guaranteed for these students. Please see

Study Abroad Research Student: for PGR students only, students can stay for any length of time up to 1 year. The tuition fee for 2011/12 is £1,160 per month. Accommodation is not guaranteed for these students. Please see

Guest Research Student: for PGR students only, students can stay for any length of time up to 1 year. Guest Research Students must be invited by the department with approval from the HoD and Dean. A supervisor must be allocated to the student and the student must be treated in the same fashion as a degree-seeking student, i.e. if PhD students are allocated work space, then the Guest Research Student is entitled to the same. The tuition fee is £310 per month and is payable by the Department, or the student, or a sponsor.

Please see below for information from the Tuition Fees Paper for 2011-12 issued by the Tuition Fees Working Group:

Guest Research Students are students invited to work with a particular academic in order to increase the department's research output or further an academic collaboration. Guest Research Students will be billed £300 for each month registered at Royal Holloway. This fee can be charged directly to the student, or to the department, or split between the two. To be eligible as a Guest Research Student there must be a RHUL academic who makes the case the invitation (including specifying the amount to be charged to the department if the guest research scholar is not directly paying the whole amount). This case has to have the expressed unequivocal written support of the Head of Department and the relevant Dean. The Director of Royal Holloway International will authorise the Guest Research Student status to staff responsible for student records and fee billing.

All of these students must complete the online application for admission.
