RECYCLING BIN

Collected fortnightly.



Remember, all items that go in your recycling bin should be:

- **Recyclable** – otherwise the whole lorry load may be rejected and not recycled
- **Clean** – rinse items before putting them in the bin
- **Dry** – do not put wet paper or card into the bin
- **Loose** – don't put items in the bin in bin liners or bags

Remember – Items must fit into one small, tied carrier bag that is placed next to your food waste bin. Batteries must be put into a separate small bag.

CHRISTMAS RECYCLING TIPS

Food waste

Reduce food waste by planning shops in advance, freezing food and using up leftovers.

Cardboard boxes

Flatten boxes to give you more space in your blue bin. Don't forget to remove any polystyrene/bubble wrap (put this in your black bin).

Wrapping paper

Please only buy and recycle wrapping paper and cards that are not lined with foil or plastic, don't have glitter on and don't contain batteries.

Adverse weather

If there is adverse weather during the Christmas period check website for updates.
