



Headstart Discover Maths and Physics Summer School FAQs

When will the Headstart Discover Maths and Physics Summer School take place?

The summer school will be held Tuesday 24 to Friday 27 June 2014.

Where will the Summer School be held?

The Headstart Summer School will be held on our beautiful Surrey campus, located close to London Heathrow and Windsor, and just 40 minutes by train from Central London. Directions can be found [here](#). If you are travelling to the Summer School by public transport, a station shuttle bus to and from our campus will be provided.

Who is running the summer school?

The event will be run by Royal Holloway staff and Student Ambassadors, in partnership with Headstart. All event staff are fully DBS (formerly CRB) checked and trained.

Where will I be staying?

You will be staying in your own room, in newly built accommodation with an en-suite bathroom. You will be in a single sex flat, with one staff member per flat to guarantee your safety. Our members of staff will be on call 24 hours per day in case you need any help or support while staying with us.

How will I make friends, I'm worried about not knowing anyone!

Our full programme of social activities is designed to help you to make friends with the other Summer School attendees. When you arrive, we'll be holding some 'ice breaker' activities to make sure that you can all get to know each other before our academic programme begins!

What do I need to bring?

We have a casual dress code, so please bring whatever you feel comfortable in, but make sure you have enough clothes for four days, as well as clothes to change into for our evening activities if you would like to. Towels and bed linen will be provided, but remember to bring toiletries.

I have special requirements, can you cater for me?

Yes. Before the Summer School, we will send you registration documents, which will have an opportunity for you to list any dietary requirements, allergies, health issues, disabilities, access requirements, religious or cultural considerations that you may have, so that we can ensure necessary arrangements are made.
