Aim: To provide a free weekly audio tape of current local news and information to visually-impaired people living in Spelthorne.

Role:

- Readers: reading parts of a provided script on a team with others, recorded. This is ideally someone with a clear & interesting voice, excellent English and who is able to get to Shepperton to recording sessions when required to do so.
- Recorders: attending the recording session to record the tape on their equipment. You must be experienced in this field

Training:

- Readers: attendance as observer at recording session on one or two occasions; making short demo audio tapes of readings (approx. 5 mins); feedback given from visually impaired STN committee members.
- Recorders: observing several recording sessions; recording with supervision, then solo when ready.

Location: Shepperton based.

Times: 7pm - 9.30pm Thursdays.

DBS: A DBS is not required for this project.

Other: Volunteers will be reimbursed travel expenses.
