Aim: The People's Theatre Company aim to provide: accessible drama opportunities for all by combining high quality projects, shows and workshops, with low cost tickets in local areas, free resources to help aspiring artists with their education and professional development, with an emphasis on lifelong learning and signposts to employment and a platform to showcase new talent with original new productions.

Role: They welcome applications from anyone with an interest in the theatre whether that is as a performer, director, designer, stage manager, fundraiser, technician or administrator.

Training: All volunteers are overseen by professional staff and training and the work asked of them is tailored to the individuals existing strengths and aspirations.

Location: Egham

Times: Different roles require different time commitments. For example if you wanted to work on a specific production you might be required quite intensively but over a short period whereas if you were interested in the administrative side of things a little less full on, more steady schedule would work.

CRB: Not required

Other: Creativity, organisation and practical skills are useful. Volunteers will gain real world experience of what it is like to work with and/or run a professional theatre company.
