Aim: To provide a working farm environment for people with special needs to participate in animal care, horticulture and horse riding.

Role: The tasks will involve working with the animals when required, cleaning out animal pens, horticulture, helping with the horses and lessons and helping with the visiting groups when required.

Training: Training is conducted on the job. An induction will also be conducted in order to get people used to the farm and there will always be a member of staff on site. However, levels of supervision will vary.

Location: Based in Longford, Heathrow – other side of Staines.

Times: Monday – Friday: anytime between 7.30am - 3.30pm

CRB: A CRB disclosure required via the Community Action office.

Other: This project has accessibility.
