Aim: Health Poverty Action works to improve the health of poor and marginalised people in Africa, Asia and Latin America. The marginalised communities that we work with may be on the edge of society because of ethnicity, culture, gender, geography, politics, economics or any combination of these. We work in partnership with the world's poorest people to grow local expertise in health services and disease prevention so that communities can survive and thrive. At the same time we campaign to change the policies and practices that create and sustain poverty and poor health.

Roles: The following positions are currently available:

- Event assistant volunteers to help at various events they have this year, from film screenings to 5km awareness raising walks.
- Charity collection volunteer
- Sporting events supporter

Training: Introduction to the organisation and the role. The volunteer will be supervised during their volunteering.

Location: Various places

Times:

- Event assistant volunteers and sporting events supporter: they require volunteers for occasional events which take place either at the weekend or on a week day.
- Charity collection volunteer: two hour shift in a morning, afternoon, or early evening time slot.
