Aim: Help the Aged is an international charity fighting to free disadvantaged older people from poverty, isolation and neglect. They campaign for change in government policy, undertake research into the needs of older people and provide local services in communities across the UK and overseas.

Role: They always on the lookout for new volunteers who can spare a morning, afternoon or even a few days each week to help raise funds for disadvantaged older people. Help the Aged has over 370 shops throughout the country and like any other retail business on the high street, it takes exactly the same skills to run them profitably. If you want to get involved, they are always seeking volunteers as Sales Assistants, Stock Preparers, Music Enthusiasts, Book Enthusiasts and Collectables Enthusiasts.

Training: Volunteers will go through training and induction sessions as well as risk assessment.

Location: In Egham they run a retail outlet which needs volunteers to assist within the business.

Times: Mon - Sat 9am-5pm (morning or afternoon sessions).

CRB: No CRB check required.

Other: Volunteers are required to supply two references.
