Aim: Free to Dance is an awareness- and fundraising campaign of LearnBurma, a registered non-partisan educational charity dedicated to opening the eyes of millions of young people to the situation in Burma, and inspiring a new generation to make a difference to it. Through campaigns such as Free to Dance, by training teachers, students and Burma supporters in the UK, and by linking schools together globally, LearnBurma brings Burma alive.

Role: LearnBurma are looking for dynamic individuals who would like to be Team Leaders and can represent Free to Dance in their local area.

Training: Team Leaders are invited to a thorough induction/training session which introduces all the information they need to fulfil the role. They will also have a 1:1 induction (this may be Skype/phone). The Team Leaders Project Manager will provide regular supervision and be on hand to provide support and advice. They will also be supported by a community of other team leaders.

Location: Local Area

Times: Team Leaders volunteer in their own time from a location that suits them. You will commit to about an hour a week fitted around your other commitments.

CRB: A CRB disclosure is not required for this project.

Other: This is a great opportunity to develop skills, meet new people, and be involved in an amazing world record attempt.
