London Air Ambulance

Aim: London's Air Ambulance is based at the Royal London Hospital and founded in 1989; the service is unique in that it operates 24/7, with the helicopter running in daylight hours and rapid response cars taking over at night. The team, which at all times includes a senior trauma doctor and a specially trained paramedic, attends an average of seven missions a day. They fundraise in a variety of ways from big events such as the Golf Challenge and 5k Regents Park Fun Run to smaller community events and collections. They heavily rely on the work of volunteers to keep the London's Air Ambulance operational.

Role: At the moment they particularly need volunteers in the following areas: To attend collections at train stations, supermarkets and shopping centres; To attend community events as a charity representative and talk to people on their behalf, sell their merchandise and promote events; To organise fundraising events within your community; To collect and distribute their collection pots; To man their charity shop based at The Royal London Hospital

Training: Full support will be provided.

Location: Various locations across London.

Times: Flexible.

CRB: CRB disclosure is not required.

Other: Ability to travel into the fundraising office at the Royal London Hospital
