Aim: Rainbow Trust Children's Charity supports families who have a child with a life threatening or terminal illness. How do you parent without a future, knowing that your child may die before you? This is the reality for parents of life threatened or terminally ill children. Rainbow Trust's goal is simple: to help families cope with something so traumatic it is impossible to imagine. They do this by providing Family Support Workers who become a trusted part of the family.

Role:

- Fundraisers

You will be supported all the way with the help from our experienced community fundraising team.

- Stock Donation Advisor

- Role: Event Support

Events range from local fetes and fairs, sporting events, cash collections, concerts, Christmas wrapping days, to high profile dinners and balls!

Training: Training varies according to the role.

Location: Leatherhead.

Times:

- Administrative support: Monday – Fridays, 9-5pm.
- Volunteer Night: Tuesday evenings. 5 - 7:30pm.
- Event support: Evenings and weekends. Times vary according to role.

DBS: This project does not require a DBS

Other: This project will reimburse travel expenses and has accessibility.
