Aim: The RNLI is the charity that saves lives at sea. It has been around since 1824 and is unique in being totally funded by the public. It provides 24 hour coverage around the country with its fleet of lifeboats, and patrols beaches during the summer season with the lifeguard service.

Role: RNLI attend local fairs such as Magna Carta Day, Englefield Green fair, Virginia Water carnival, Staines regatta and Egham Royal Show with a stall selling RNLI goods on behalf of the charity. They also hold a yearly street collection in various local towns. They're looking for anyone with an interest in the work of Lifeboats and Lifeguards and who wish to give a little something back to help the brave volunteers who risk their lives to save others.

Location: In and around the local area.

Times: Street collections are held during the Sept - Mar period. Fairs, fetes and shows tend to be Apr - Aug.

CRB: No CRB is needed for this project.

Other: This project will reimburse travel expense and has accessibility.
