Aim: The Woking and Sam Beare Hospice has a mission to: promote the provision of the highest possible standard of care for people with a life limiting illness and to provide support and help for patients, families and carers.

Role: Volunteer Retail Assistants are needed at charity shops in Virginia Water, Egham, Weybridge, Walton and Chertsey.

There are other volunteer roles which may involve working in the hospice or for the charities children's services.

Training: All retail volunteers have training provided by the shop Manager. Support is provided and always available from the Volunteer Services Department.

Location: Varied

Times: Volunteers are required to work one of two shifts: 9:30 – 1pm or 1pm – 4:30. However, there are more flexible hours for those wishing to help out with fundraising and charity events for the Hospice.

CRB: A CRB disclosure is not required for the retail assistant positions but will be required for the other roles in the children's services.

Other: Volunteers should be committed, reliable and have an understanding or empathy for our services and ethos.
