**Aim:** To provide a comprehensive range of general and acute clinical services across the two hospital sites. Their slogan is: 'Putting people at the heart of everything we do'

**Role:** There are a range of roles for volunteers to choose from: ward support (adult and children); reception/enquiry desk; shop trolley round; clerical portering and even ward visiting on behalf of the chaplaincy group projects.

**Training:** A Placement induction and mandatory Trust Induction Day that takes place the first Monday of every month at Ashford Hospital. Volunteers will also be given a named supervisor/placement support. Other training sessions will be arranged according to the role and need through the Voluntary Services Department and the Trust's Training Department.

**Location:** Chertsey.

**Times:** For the Wards/Portering and Ward visiting - 8a.m. - 8p.m. Daily. Other roles are mainly 9a.m. - 5.00p.m. on weekdays.

**CRB:** A CRB disclosure is required via the Community Partner.
