Aim: To work flat out to get every child their rights as fast as possible.

Role: Save the Children are looking for 'Emergency Fundraisers' - volunteers who are asked to raise money for emergencies as soon as they happen. You can do anything you wish to raise the money within a couple of weeks from hosting a tea party, or taking a collection tin around work.

Training: None needed! All you have to do to be an Emergency Fundraiser is sign up on the website (savethechildren.org.uk/hero). Then, when an emergency happens let Save the Children know if you want to fundraise and they'll send you a pack.

Location: Anywhere and everywhere.

Times: Emergency fundraising is a totally flexible form of volunteering. Simply sign up and, when an emergency happens, they are sent information and advice about fundraising for a specific emergency.

CRB: No CRB disclosure is required.

Other: Fundraising ideas need to be submitted in advance to Save the Children UK for risk assessment and recording activities.
